Office Expenses	32,610.00	Includes office equipment and technology, phone and internet, hospitality, and other misc. office supplies.
Building Maintenance	20,000.00	Annual maintenance expeneses for the Arts & Wellness Center and Rosa Keller Library Community Center.
Rent & Utilities	35,000.00	Annual rent paid to Blessed Trinity Church for the Arts & Wellness Center.
Landscaping	3,000.00	Includes maintenance of three community gardens throughout Broadmoor, including the Broadmoor Food Forest, Broadmoor Rain Garden, and the Broadmoor Food Pantry garden.
Program Supplies	19,950.00	Includes additional food and other supplies for the Broadmoor Food Pantry, and supplies for neighborhood beautification projects and other quality of life programs.
Emergency Assistance	1,650.00	Utility and transportation assistance available to Broadmoor residents in need.
Community Outreach	12,300.00	Includes cost to print and send newsletters to all households in Broadmoor, online marketing and other outreach tools, and the BIA's mass texting application.
